Timber Mountain Lookout is located within the Double Head Ranger District, approximately 30 miles south of Tulelake, California. The legal location of the tower is Township 44 North, Range 6 East, Section 29, M.D.M. The first 27 miles are paved highway and the remaining 3 miles are graveled roads. If traveling from Tulelake, go south on State Highway 139 for approximately 25 miles. Turn right onto County Road 97 continuing for 1 mile, then turn left on Forest Service road 44N66 and follow the signs to the lookout. This lookout is of steel construction, and visitors will need to climb three stairways to reach the cab or "live-in" part of the tower. Please use caution when climbing the stairs.
